*All appropriate fees, deposits, and completed contract are due at the time of booking.

If you are providing entertainment for your party, please describe:

- We are unable to accept reservations without payment in full and a completed contract.
All parties must be booked a minimum of two weeks in advance of chosen date to accommodate staffing.
No party will be booked less than two weeks prior to the date.
Cancellations must be made no later than 48 hours prior to the date of the party in order to obtain a refund or reschedule the party.
You are welcome to bring food and drink items into the facility during your event, however all food and drink items must be kept in the party room area.
For any underage party (attendees under 18), one adult 25 years or older must be in attendance for every 10 attendees, with a minimum of 2 adults.
Please note that the Party Room can comfortably seat 20 people.
Pool rules apply. Please read before signing and review with guests prior to visit.

Aquatic Center Rules and Regulations

Supervision Guidelines

All children age 10 and under must be accompanied by a responsible person (age 16 or older) while using the facility.

The responsible person (age 16 or older) must be in the water, within arm's reach of a child who is under age 6. Maximum 3 children/responsible person.

The responsible person must be in the pool area while the child ages 6-10 is use the pool.

Infants and Toddlers in or around the water should be within arm's reach of an adult at all times.

Swim Test

Lifeguards reserve the right to swim test anyone, prior to allowing them to swim in deep water.

Pool Rules

1. Obey the lifeguards at all times. **Failure to do so may result in loss of pool privileges.**
2. A lifeguard must be on duty before anyone enters the pool.
3. Swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
4. Proper swim attire is required. No street shoes allowed on decks.
5. U.S. Coast Guard approved flotation devices are allowed. Inflatable flotation devices are not allowed (i.e. - water wings, rafts, inner tubes, etc.)
6. Those not toilet-trained (incontinent) entering the pool must wear clean diaper or swim diaper covered by separate rubber/vinyl pants which must fit snugly around the legs and waist. Diapers shall be changed only in locker rooms or family change rooms..
7. During cool weather below 70 degrees, the outdoor pool will not open. If the temperature drops below 70 degrees after opening, the pool will remain open unless conditions merit closing for safety reasons.
8. During storms, the outdoor pool will close and the area cleared of patrons at the discretion of the Manager. The pool will normally re-open 15 minutes after the storm has passed.
9. No running, pushing, dunking, spitting, excessive splashing or horseplay.
10. No playing or swinging on railings and ladders.
11. Diving is permitted only in the deep end (6' depth or greater).
12. Twirling jumps, flips, back dives and backward entries into the water are not allowed.
13. Underwater breath-holding for extended periods or distance is not allowed.
14. No food, drink (except clear plastic water bottles), or gum is allowed on the pool deck or in the locker rooms outside the designated area.
15. Glass containers are prohibited.
16. Possession or use of alcohol or drugs is prohibited. Anyone suspected of being under the influence will be asked to leave the facility.
17. Smoking is prohibited in the aquatic center and outdoor pool area.
18. Profane or abusive language and inappropriate displays of affection are prohibited and may result in expulsion.
19. Swimmers with open wounds/sores or communicable diseases are not allowed.
20. No pets are allowed in the aquatic center.
21. The City of Warrenton is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Group Use Guidelines

1. Groups of 10 or more are required to notify aquatic center management in advance in order to schedule their visit.
2. Reservation requests must be received a minimum of 24 hours in advance and can be denied due to staffing.
3. Before entering the water, groups will be required to review the aquatic facility rules and regulations with aquatic staff.

Diving Board Rules

1. Only one person allowed on the board at any time.
2. Persons in line must wait until the previous diver has cleared the area before climbing on the diving board.
3. Safe diving must be practiced. No running, cartwheels, handstands, inward dives or multiple bounces on the diving board. Diver must dive straight out from the board.
4. Diver must demonstrate swimming ability.
5. No inflatable devices or assistance is allowed.

Slide & Water Playground Rules

1. Only one person allowed on slide at a time.
2. Before a slider may go down the slide they must wait for lifeguard signals that it is safe to do so.
3. Sliders must go down the slide in a sitting position or on back with feet first.
4. Sliders must exit pool at the nearest ladder after sliding.
5. Sliders may not be caught in the catch pool (area below the slide).
6. Goggles, fins, watches, zippers, buckles, or flotation devices may not be worn on the slide.
7. Only children under 48" tall may use the water playground.

Violation of any of these rules may result in expulsion for the remainder of the day. Repeated violations may result in permanent expulsion. These rules are not all inclusive and may change at management's discretion. It is the responsibility of the patron to read and obey all aquatic center rules to ensure safety.

It is hereby agreed that:
